

Criteria

High School Bursary

- Be a registered Ts'kw'aylaxw Band Member.
- Graduate with a Dogwood Diploma.
- Accepted into a full or part time Post Secondary Institute

Post Secondary Bursary

- Be a registered Ts'kw'aylaxw Band Member.
- Submit official copy of transcripts of last two semesters.
- Returning to Post Secondary Institute in September current year.

Selection Process

Applications will be accepted from August 1st until August 31st each year. These bursaries are distributed each year and a new application must be submitted each year.

High School Bursary

The high school bursary will go to the student with the Highest Grade Point Average (GPA)

Post Secondary Bursary

The post secondary bursary will go to the student with the Highest Grade Point Average (GPA)

Applications

All members who wish to apply for the Graymont Bursaries need to complete the application form for the designated bursary of their choice, and will also need to submit the following information;

High School Bursary

- Completed Graymont Bursary High School Application
- Transcripts from Grade 12
- Copy of Dogwood Diploma
- Current Resume
- Two letters of reference
- Letter of acceptance to a Post Secondary Institute

Post Secondary Bursary

- Completed Graymont Bursary Post Secondary Application
- Transcripts from current year of study
- Two letters of reference
- Current resume

Incomplete applications will not be accepted. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all required information is submitted prior to the deadline.

Eligibility

Post secondary students that have received a Graymont Post Secondary Bursary prior will not be eligible for any future Graymont Post Secondary Bursaries.

High school students that have received a Graymont High School Bursary are still eligible to apply for the Graymont Post Secondary Bursary.

Distribution

The Education Coordinator will calculate each applicants GPA and the applicant with the highest GPA will receive the bursary. This will be the same for both the High School and Post Secondary bursaries. The Education Coordinator will forward the recommendation to Chief and Council for final approval. Once final approval is received a cheque will be processed for one high school student in the amount of \$1000.00 and one cheque for a post secondary student in the amount of \$1000.00

Publication

In accepting either the High School or Post Secondary Bursary from Ts'kw'aylaxw the recipient agrees to the decision to place or publicize information in any newsletter or public paper. Ts'kw'aylaxw reserves the right to publish any information pertaining to the Graymont High School Bursary and Graymont Post Secondary Bursary.

Amendments

Amendments will be suggested by the Education Committee and presented to Chief and Council for final approval. Any amendments from the Education Committee to Chief and Council can only be made at a scheduled Education Committee meeting.
